The Common Criteria is an international security evaluation standard utilised by companies that supply security or security-enabled solutions to undergo formal evaluations to demonstrate that their security functionality performs as specified. For many U.S. departments and agencies, information assurance or information assurance-enabled products must undergo a Common Criteria evaluation prior to its acquisition in accordance with the National Security Telecommunications and Information Systems Security Policy No. 11. Common Criteria certification also provides non-governmental businesses and organisations with confidence that the IT security solutions they have deployed have been tested and approved by a third-party organisation.
